



Senior Environmental Field Technician, Driller/Engineer – Vista GeoScience

Vista GeoScience is looking to grow its national environmental drilling and remediation field services operations and has an *IMMEDIATE* need for an experienced environmental drilling and chemical injection technician. This position requires experience in the environmental field service industry as a lead field technician and or project manager.

Duties include:

- Completion of field events using direct push sampling and hollow stem auger rigs to collect soil/groundwater samples
- Monitoring well installation, chemical injection services
- Working with Mip/HiPT/EC and investigative fluorescence tools.
- Problem solving and flexibility is also key to the success of this staff member and the candidate will need to provide experience in developing junior staff members, field project summaries, fabrication projects, and equipment or truck maintenance and repair.

For the right candidate, the position would likely include:

- Management of local and national projects including preparing equipment
- Ensuring consumables are on hand
- Ensuring field crew have proper training to complete field projects
- Completing or review of required permits, write or review health and safety plans, manage project cost, prepare written summary reports
- Provide overall management of field performance.

Preferences:

- Drilling experienced preferred including hollow stem auger, rotary, or direct push.
- Hydraulic system repair – hydraulic hose replacement, cylinder repairs, scheduled maintenance, and general upkeep.
- Electrical system trouble shooting – AC 120/240 system wiring. DC systems charging, solenoids, switches, lighting, pump repair, etc.
- Light fabrication – welding, cutting, plasma cutting, metal working, and drilling tools repair.
- Light truck maintenance and repairs – diesel and gasoline motor trouble shooting and repairs, drive train trouble shooting, electrical systems trouble shooting.
- Training – manage SOP's disbursement and revisions, manage drivers training of new technicians, manage training technicians of drilling techniques, manage technician training of chemical injection services.
- Licensing – Licensed or able to obtain drilling or contractor license utilizing experience.

- Microsoft Office programs – able to produce and review Excel and Word documents and manage a professional Outlook account.
